The assessment is invoiced by Souderton Telford Main Streets on behalf of the Borough of Souderton in order to ensure the most timely collection and availability of the funds.



Bringing foot traffic to the streets is part of our mission and the 3rd Friday events begun by Downtown Scoop on Chestnut Street presented the perfect opportunity to grow.

Asset Enhancement

Banners: We have purchased our first set of banners and hardware to advertise the district and the 3rd Friday events. The banners in the hollow have been hung. The larger banners are coming to Broad, County Line and Main Street.

Our thanks to the Borough of Souderton for their assistance by providing the labor to put up the banners for us.

Holiday Decor: Holiday Banners and lights will be installed in the district for the 2017 holiday season. The Borough has agreed to assist us in getting power to the poles and the installation of the banners and lighted decorations which will be purchased by the BID.

Planters: Imago Dei have generously donated beautifully built wooden planters for distribution to property owners in the district. Eight are available and will be distributed based on a drawing at the membership meeting.

Curbside Maintenance: We recognize how important a well kept appearance is to the district as a whole and are looking for chemical-free ways to control weeds and improve the overall appearance of the district's sidewalks and curbs.
